

Testing Overview

Standardized Testing

Each Caroline D. Bradley Scholarship applicant must submit scores for a school administered, nationally normed standardized test for the past two years.

Qualified tests

- CAT/5
- ERB
- Iowa Test of Basic Skills
- Stanford 9
- Terranova

In order to qualify for the Scholarship, applicants must be in the 97th percentile in at least one of the major academic areas for at least the past two years. If your school administers a test not found the on the list above, please contact the *Institute for Educational Advancement* at 626-403-8900 to confirm eligibility.

Acceptable academic areas include keywords such as:

- Total Reading, Total Mathematics, Language, Total Battery, Total Score

Unacceptable academic areas include keywords such as:

- Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension, Problem Solving, Procedures, Language Mechanics/Expression/Usage, Punctuation, Spelling, Expression, Computation

Standardized test score reports should be sent directly to IEA by the applicant.

SAT Reasoning Test

Each Caroline D. Bradley Scholarship applicant must take the SAT Reasoning Test to be considered for this award. It is the applicant's responsibility to register for the test and arrange for the scores to be sent to IEA. It is common practice among Gifted and Talent Searches to require SAT testing. If you took the SAT earlier this year please contact The College Board to have a copy of your scores sent to IEA (score code 3862).
